

19. No Smoking Policy

At Little Faces Nursery we are committed to promoting children's health and well-being. This is of the utmost importance for the nursery. Smoking has proved to be a health risk and therefore in accordance with legislation, the nursery operates a strict no smoking policy within its buildings and grounds. It is illegal to smoke in enclosed places.

All persons must abstain from smoking while on the premises. This applies to staff, students, parents, carers, contractors and any other visitors to the premises.

Staff accompanying children outside the nursery, are not permitted to smoke. We also request that parents accompanying nursery children on outings refrain from smoking while caring for the children.

Staff must not smoke while displaying nursery uniform as it is essential that staff are positive role models to children and promote a healthy lifestyle. If staff choose to smoke during breaks they are asked to cover their uniform or change into their own clothes and smoke away from the main entrance.

There is a designated smoking area in the college, away from the main building.

This policy also applies to electronic cigarettes.
